THE GEORGE H. LAUFENBERG SCHOLARSHIP

The George H. Laufenberg Scholarship was started in 1996, in memory of long time New Jersey Funds Director George H. Laufenberg. Since its inception in 1996, the George H. Laufenberg Scholarship has presented 330 scholarships totaling over \$2 million to the children and grandchildren of union carpenters.

For the year 2012, the Selection Committee has awarded 21 scholarships, valued at \$31,000.00. Over the course of their college careers, the scholarships will be worth a total of \$124,000.00 to this year's recipients. In addition, a onetime scholarship payment of \$500.00 was awarded to each applicant who submitted a completed application, bringing the total committed for the year to \$179,500.00.

In April of 2011, the Empire State Regional council of Carpenters merged with the New Jersey Regional Council of Carpenters making all children and grandchildren of members of the North East Regional Council of Carpenters eligible for the scholarship
